EXCHANGING FUNDS

WHEN AN ENTITY THAT HAS FUNDS ON DEPOSIT WITH FIDES, WITH FTAM, OR WITH NVC, REQUESTS THAT FUNDS BE MOVED TO ANOTHER INSTITUTION...

...A SELECTED INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR WILL SEND A REQUEST THROUGH A CENTER TO A MASTER CENTER, AND THE MASTER CENTER WILL SEND THE REQUEST TO INVAG.

...INVAG WILL UNDERTAKE TO EXCHANGE FUNDS HELD IN FIDES, FTAM, OR NVC, USING THE PROTOCOL http://www.change2100.com/THIBMART/EXCHANGING
FUNDS FOR FIDES FTAM AND NVC ACCOUNT HOLDERS.pdf

...WITH INVAG PRESENTING BUSINESS TO USPES ON BEHALF OF THE ENTITY REQUESTING THE MOVEMENT OF FUNDS.

TRANSFERRING FUNDS

ONCE THE PROTOCOL FOR EXCHANGING FUNDS HAS BEEN ACTIVATED...

...ON BEHALF OF AN ENTITY REQUESTING FUNDS BE MOVED...

...AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR MAY ARRANGE FOR TRANSFERS FROM FIDES, FROM FTAM, OR FROM NVC AS MAY BE NEGOTIATED WITH THESE INSTITUTIONS AND WITH THE INSTITUTIONS RECEIVING THE FUNDS...

...IN WHICH CASE...

...ONCE PROCEEDS FROM THE PROTOCOL FOR EXCHANGING FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE...

...AN ALLOCATION WILL BE MADE TO CLEAR VALUES THAT WERE TRANSFERRED...

...AS PER REGULATIONS AND POLICIES OF FIDES, FTAM, NVC, AND ENTITIES TO WHICH FUNDS WERE TRANSFERRED.
