USE OF DEPOSITS WITH FIDES AND ACRBI

[FIDES GESTION FINANCIERA, S.A.P.I. DE C.V.](#) (“FIDES”) is regulated by SECRETARIA DE HACIENDA Y CREDITO PUBLICO (“SHCP”), that is the MEXICO TREASURY DEPARTMENT.

[APEX CAPITAL RESERVE BANK Inc.](#) (“ACRBI”) is a RESERVE BANK of the STATE OF SCNRFP, which is a world recognized SOVEREIGN NATION, and ACRBI operates out of a DIPLOMATIC MISSION.

FIDES uses ACRBI as a DEPOSITORY, with all funds deposited therein by FIDES complying with all legal requirements for M 1 funds to be used at will.

Conditions for a DEPOSITOR to be accepted by FIDES and ACRBI are stringent, and it should be considered a privilege to be accepted.

Account holders may do business with each other, requesting transfers of funds from one account to another.

However, transferring funds to other institutions may only take place if the other institution complies with FIDES and ACRBI requirements, not the other way around!

The difficulties of transferring to other coordinates provides safety to DEPOSITORS, in addition to diplomatic protections and extraordinary value of assets backing all deposits with ACRBI, provided by a Principal Owner of ACRBI who is also a very major DEPOSITOR with FIDES, and is an AMBASSADOR FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT for several AUTONOMOUS AND SOVEREIGN JURISDICTIONS that adhere to UNCITRAL.

FIDES may issue INTERNATIONAL BILLS OF EXCHANGE (“IBOE”) subject to Mexican Law, and to UNCITRAL.

When doing business with residents of Texas, such as the owners of ACRBI and of FIDES, Texas Law is also applicable, which includes [25. FORT HANCOCK WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT](#), [119. TEXAS LONG ARM STATUTE](#), historically [353. PRECEDENT COURT CASE RULING THAT IBOE AND PN ARE CASH FUNDS](#), and Texas Court cases specifically regarding FIDES IBOE.

Thus, value deposited through FIDES with ACRBI may be used as collateral for FIDES IBOE, which arguably may be used as UNITED STATES DOLLARS cash funds in any settlement anywhere wherein UNITED STATES DOLLARS are acceptable, with the condition that said IBOE may be exchangeable for UNITED STATES DOLLARS deposited in any regulated institution that accepts UNITED STATES DOLLARS.

Such exchanges may be made by FIDES, on behalf of a DEPOSITOR, requesting ACRBI to transfer funds to coordinates of a FINANCIAL ENTITY that accepts transfers via LEDGER TO LEDGER, EBANQ API, or KTT, subject to ISO 20022; and, if necessary, arranging for the ENTITY to transfer funds to coordinates as requested by the DEPOSITOR.

Alternatively, FIDES also holds CRYPTO on deposit in WALLETS controlled by FIDES, and may exchange funds deposited with ACRBI for CRYPTO that FIDES may hold, transferring the CRYPTO to a WALLET designated by the DEPOSITOR.

If CRYPTO requested by the DEPOSITOR is not available, in conjunction with the DEPOSITOR, FIDES may facilitate a purchase of the CRYPTO requested.

Alternatively, a DEPOSITOR may execute [3203. COMMERCE COFFEE CRYPTO CASH FOR AN APPROVED GOOD CAUSE](#) up to the full amount held on deposit by FIDES, repetitively, without depletion of the funds held on deposit by FIDES, to obtain equal value of the deposited amount with each repetition.

It should be noted that any use of this protocol is not a passive investment by a DEPOSITOR, but requires full cooperation and involvement of the DEPOSITOR in the process.

In short, use of FIDES and ACRBI, combined, by a DEPOSITOR, is a vehicle for a DEPOSITOR to enhance the DEPOSITOR'S business transactions, not to be considered the same as funds that may be placed with other institutions, and the DEPOSITOR is responsible for success of all transactions.

That is, FIDES and ACRBI are there to help a DEPOSITOR perform, not to perform for the DEPOSITOR!
