When doing business within the Jurisdiction of Ugwaku Autonomous Community or with entities governed by said authority, using UNITED STATES DOLLARS, the word "may" in the USA FEDERAL RESERVE ACT SECTION 13 must be interpreted as "shall". This restriction is only applicable within the jurisdiction of the authority issuing this order.

As considered within the boundaries of this publication, exercising our sovereign rights, shall pass our own laws regulating "money" and "monetary policy". But when allowing business to be done using UNITED STATES DOLLARS within our jurisdiction, or when doing business ourselves using UNITED STATES DOLLARS, all rules, regulations, and laws related directly or indirectly to the use of UNITED STATES DOLLARS, depending on our content and objectives, may be subrogated to the laws passed by the USA Congress and as interpreted by USA Courts and Nigeria constitutions in form of National Assembly Acts, State Government or Laws, and Local Government laws and in Nigeria courts and Government Agencies regulations.

Putting the above into practice, unless otherwise prohibited by law, will economically empower our taxing authority within our jurisdiction to provide TAX CREDITS to any entity that may wish to do business within said jurisdiction.

This EXECUTIVE ORDER suggests that, the taxing authority within the jurisdiction of Ugwaku Autonomous Community, Imo State Nigeria, shall issue tax credits formulated as per the TEXAS HOLDINGS INC. 2016 BUSINESS MODEL, as a means to resolve our current economic issues.
